Services provided will include examinations, cleaning, emergency treatment, preventative services, extractions, root canals, full and partial dentures, crowns, and bridges in patients of all ages. The job demands someone who exemplifies positive patient treatment through professional and compassionate care, understands dentistry practices and protocols particularly within rural community settings, and who is well organized, pro-active, and disciplined to stay on top of multiple priorities. The incumbent needs to be adaptable and objective enough to meet dental care needs in small clinic locations with minimal resources. Finally, the incumbent must build and maintain positive relationships while actively and respectfully listening, communicating, and executing realistic protocols for the communities, organization, and other stakeholders.



This is a P/T or F/T position providing services across multiple sites throughout the Aleutian chain (Adak, Akutan, Cold Bay, False Pass, King Cove, Nelson Lagoon & Sand Point).

EAT is determined to find an experienced and competent dentist. As such, to compete for this position, candidates must possess:

- Graduation from Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) dental program.
- Current Alaska licensure or able to obtain an Alaska license to practice dentistry.
- Three (3) years of dental experience preferred.
- Experience with multiple-site staffing is preferred.
