This is a full-time position and located in King Cove, Sand Point, Cold Bay, False Pass, or Adak, Alaska.

To compete for this position, candidates must possess:

- Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant education/certification
- Alaska NP/PA License (eligible to receive upon first day of employment)
- No less than five (5) years of experience in Primary Care and/or Emergency Care
- ACLS certification
- Experience in tribal health or rural health care is preferred.
- Experience in rural cross culture setting is preferred.

Selected candidates may be eligible for relocation expense reimbursement and signing bonus. Full time employees receive a host of benefits, including malpractice insurance coverage and CEUs. Providers may qualify for loan repayment through the NHSC, or I.H.S.
