Opportunities for **full-time, part-time, or relief (as needed) positions** exist in **all clinics served by Eastern Aleutian Tribes**. Hourly pay starts at a minimum of \$17.50 per hour, with benefits for full-time employees, and a **\$1,000 signing bonus for applicants hired before 12/31/2021** is offered.

To compete for this position, candidates must be 18 years old or older and possess:

- A high school diploma or GED equivalent
- Valid driver's license (insurable by EAT)
- Basic Life Support (BLS) certification
